CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

- 1 Applicants must be female
- 2 Applicants must be living in, or have come from, the area covered by Blackall Range Zonta Club (Beerwah to Peachester to Conondale, Kenilworth, Palmwoods and Landsborough, west of the Bruce Highway, South of the Eumundi/Kenilworth Road)
- 3 Applicants must have commenced studying for a tertiary qualification or equivalent in a chosen field
- 4 Applicants must show that they require financial assistance to further their studies or career experience and submit particulars of financial circumstances which demonstrate financial need
- 5 Applicants must already show dedication to and achievement in the chosen field
- 6 Applicants must display a commitment to voluntary work, community assistance or some altruistic community minded goals
- 7 Applicants must have defined goals and targets that they are aiming for
- 8 Applicants must supply two written references from Teacher/Tutors/Lecturers or equivalent describing level of dedication and achievement so far, which
 - a Support the application;
 - b Confirm the present level of achievement;
- 9 Applicants must submit current academic results
- 10 Applicants must submit detailed curriculum vitae
- 11 Applicants may be required to attend an interview, either in person or by phone
- 12 The successful applicant is expected to report back in 12 months to tell how she is progressing and how her money was applied
- 13 The successful applicant must be available to participate in promotion of the awarding of the scholarship
